Offence :- Punishable U/s.3 (a) of Railway Properties (Unlawful
Possession) Act, 1966.

Plea :- Guilty (A2)

Finding :- Guilty (A2)

Sentence/Order :- Accused No. 2 is convicted and sentenced to pay Rs.1,500/-
(Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred only) offence
punishable u/s 3 (a) of Railway Properties (Unlawful
Possession) Act, 1966. In default of payment of fine, he
shall undergo simple imprisonment for two weeks.

following:-

JUDGMENT

This is a case instituted on a complaint filed by the Sub Inspector, Railway Protection Force, Kollam against the accused two in numbers alleging commission of offences punishable u/s.3 (a) of Railway Properties (Unlawful Possession) Act, 1966.

2. The averments in the complaint are that on 3.5.2024 at about 18.20 hrs., accused no. 1 and 2 dishonestly taken away 2 Nos. of bend fish plate, 2 Nos. of 90R rail pieces worth Rs.4,130/- without any authority from railway property near platform No.1 of Paravur Railway Station Thereby the accused are alleged to have committed the aforesaid offence.

3. Occurrence report was filed by the Sri, P.V.Raju, Sub Inspector, Railway Protection Force, Kollam. Thereafter he conducted investigation and filed complaint. Cognizance was taken and the case was taken to the file of this court as the present case.

4. Accused No.2 is present. Copies of relevant records relied on by the prosecution were served to the accused.

5. Heard. Charge framed u/s. 3 (a) of Railway Properties (Unlawful Possession) Act, 1966, read over and explained to accused No.2, to which he pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the accused pleaded guilty voluntarily and it was accepted.

6. Accused No.2 is heard on question of sentence. He sought for leniency. I am satisfied that the action of pleading guilty and admission of guilt by the accused is a sign of remorse and hence a lenient view can be taken.

In the result, accused No.2 is convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1,500/- (Rupees One Thousand Five Hundred only) for the offence punishable u/s. 3 (a) of Railway Properties (Unlawful Possession) Act, 1966. In default of payment of fine, he shall undergo simple imprisonment for two weeks. Case against accused no.1 is split up and refiled as CC 527/2024.
