It is evident that the offence report has been filed against unknown. It is evident from the prosecution report that the Vanpal has submitted his prosecution report by mentioning that he tried much to trace the name and address of the culprit/accused, but could not trace and the case may be dismissed by confiscating the seized tempo and the 2 quintal fire woods loaded on the same. It is further evident that vide his order dated 09.09.2023 passed in confiscation Case No. 03 of 2023 duly forwarded to this court vide Memo No. 3128 dated 09.09.2023 that the case has been disposed of final and the seized and confiscated vehicle and fire wood have been directed to be sold through auction and to deposit the sale amount in treasury. But inadvertently the then PO has taken cognizance against some Briju Yadav and Ravindra Yadav, who are neither named in the offence report which is lodged against unknown nor in the offence report filed against unknown with prayer to dismissed the case due to none tracing of the accused/culprit. In such circumstances there is nothing on record to proceed further against any specific person. Hence, accepting the prayer of the Vanpal in his prosecution report forwarded with order of sanction of prosecution as reported in the prosecution report, The proceeding of the case is hereby dropped and the case is disposed of accordingly.
