JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Thenmala Police Station) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 281 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.
2. Accused was represented by counsel, the copies of relevant records relied on by the prosecution were furnished to the counsel. Counsel filed application to permit him to plead guilty on behalf of the accused. Having understood the seriousness of the allegation and the implications of pleading guilty of the plea, counsel for the accused pleaded guilty on behalf of accused. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.
3. In the result, the Accused convicted for the offence punishable under Section 281 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 300/-. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 7 Days.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
