Briefly stated, as per the case made by the investigating agency, on 04.06.2026, SI Subhash Kumar along-with other police officials was coming back from village Kishangarh towards Umri in connection with patrolling duty and on the way, a motorcyclist was seen coming in between Kishangarh and Dheru Majra. On seeing the police vehicle, that motorcyclist tried to turn towards village Dheru Majra. However, he was controlled over by the police team. Upon asking, he disclosed his name as Preet Pal Singh @ Preet i.e. the present petitioner. On suspicion of having illegal arms/weapon, SI Subhash Kumar conducted his personal search, which led to the recovery of a polythene, containing 10.75 gm Heroin.

5. Accordingly, a tehrir was written and sent to the police station, basis on which, the instant criminal case was registered. The petitioner was arrested and he was lying in judicial custody since 04.06.2026. Therefore, he moved this application for regular bail.

6. I have heard the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the accused-petitioner and the learned Public Prosecutor for the State.

7. As per the allegations, the petitioner was found having the possession of 10.75 gm Heroin on 04.06.2026 by the police team headed by SI Subhash Kumar. The quantity of the contraband, allegedly recovered from the petitioner, was intermediate i.e. more than the small quantity, but lesser than the commercial quantity. The investigation as well as subsequent trial are likely to take a considerable time and the petitioner, who is already

lying in custody since 04.06.2026, may not be kept behind bars for an indefinite period. Therefore, the bail application of the petitioner is hereby allowed, subject to his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. A copy of this order be sent to the Court of learned Illaqa Magistrate for information and necessary compliance and with the direction to forward the requisite bail bonds to this Court.

8. None of the opinion recorded above by this Court in the instant order would affect the merits of the case in any manner in future and the same are recorded only for the purpose of determination of application for bail. File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
