This petition is filed by the Counsel for the plaintiff under Order 39 Rule 1 of C.P.C 1908, for injunction. This IA have been finally heard on 12.06.2024 and the court on the same day passed the following .

**ORDER**

This application is filed under Order XXXIX Rule 1 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for temporary injunction.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner. Perused the affidavit, petition and records. I am satisfied that the petitioner has made out a prima -facie case. There are serious disputed question to be decided in the main proceedings. Further satisfied that, if time is granted till respondent's appearance, whole purpose of this petition would be defeated and may cause irreparable injury to the petitioner. It also appears that, inconvenience which is likely to occur from withholding an interim injunction will be greater than that would be likely to arise from granting an ad-interim injunction. Hence an ad-interim injunction is granted in part. The defendant is restrained from alienating the plaint schedule property to strangers and from making any encumbrance over the plaint schedule property until further orders. The plaintiff is ordered to comply with Order 39 Rule 3(a) of the C.P.C
