This petition coming on for hearing before me on 04.06.2022 and on the same day the court passed the following.

ORDER

Heard the petitioner.

Perused the affidavit in support of injunction petition, plaint and documents. I am satisfied that a prima facie case is made out justifying the grant of an ad-interim order of injunction. Prima facie the balance of convenience is found in favour of the petitioner. If interim order is not granted, irreparable injury is likely to be caused to the petitioner. Delay in sending the notice will defeat the object of granting the relief. Hence an ad-interim order of injunction is passed restraining

the defendant from trespassing into the plaint schedule property and from obstructing the possession and enjoyment of the plaintiff over the plaint schedule property and also from obstructing the plaintiff from constructing a house in the plaint schedule property until further orders.
