Sentence/order : The accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/- for offence
u/s.15(c), 63 of Kerala Abkari Act and in default of payment
of fine accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.

JUDGMENT

This case is charge sheeted by the S.I. of police, of Oachira police station Crime No.1007/2025 against the accused for the offences punishable U/s.15(c), 63 of Kerala Abkari Act

2. Accused appeared. Copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to the counsel. The accused pleaded guilty for the charge framed. I find the said plea to be voluntary with full knowledge of consequences and hence accepted. The accused is found guilty of the offence punishable and convicted there under.
3. Considering the nature of offences, I find that the benevolent provisions of Probation Act need not be invoked in the above case.
4. Even then, considering the facts and circumstances, I am inclined to take a lenient view regarding sentence.
5. The accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/-for offence u/s.15(c), 63 of Kerala Abkari Act and in default of payment of fine accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 15 days.
