Order : Application is allowed.

This petition having been heard today the court passed the following:-

ORDER

This is a petition filed U/s.497 of BNSS, for release of one mobile phone seized by the Chavara Police Station in crime No.467/2026.

2. The petitioner state that he is the owner of mobile phone 'realme RMX5061 valued at Rs.20,000/-which was seized by the Chavara south police in crime no.467/2026 registered under section 20(B)(II)A of NDPS Act. The petitioner is the 1st accused in the above crime. The police arrested the petitioner and enlarged on bail. There are no rival claimants for the custody of the mobile phone. Hence this petition is filed.
3. Copy of the petition was served to the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor. Prosecution filed report stating that mobile phone which was found in the accused now is in the possession of investigation officer after examination and ready to release.
4. Heard and perused the record. Case is already disposed as accused convicted and sentenced to pay fine Rs.4000/- The mobile phone was obtained from the personal property of the accused. Therefore, interim custody of the mobile phone is granted upon execution of bond. So the petition is allowed and the

above mobile phone released to the petitioner on the following conditions:-

- (1) The petitioner shall execute bond for Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen thousand only) with 2 solvent sureties each for like sum*
- (2) The petitioner shall furnish 2 photographs of the mobile phone taken for different angles countersigned by the petitioner and her counsel.*
- (3) The mobile phone shall not be alienated and it shall be produced before the court as and when demanded.*

Hence the petition is allowed.
