ORDER

1. This is the application for bail u/s. 480 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita filed by accused no. 12 in CP 7/2025 (Crime No. 1534/2020 of Chathannur Police Station) on the file of this court. The accused is alleged to have committed the offences punishable u/ss. 143, 147, 148, 341, 323, 324, 326, 294(b), 308, 506 (Para-1), 509 and 149 of IPC and sec. 3(a) of the Explosive Act.

2. Prosecution case in brief is as follows:- The accused were in inimical terms with CW1 and other as they questioned the act of accused selling ganja. Due to this prior enmity the accused on 26/08/2020 at 21.45 hrs. formed themselves into an unlawful assembly and in prosecution of their

common object uttered obscene words towards CW4 and accused No.1 slapped CW2 on his left cheek and 15th accused threatened to kill him. The 5th accused inserted a steel pipe into the arm pit of CW2 and twisted it causing dislocation on his right shoulder. When he fell down, the accused No. 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 15, 16 and 17 beaten and kicked him. The 1st and 15th accused beaten him on his head using a beer bottle and 5th accused beaten on his neck using the steel pipe. When CW4 tried to stop them, the 5th accused beaten on her right leg knee and thereby inflicted wound. When CW1 and CW3 rushed to the spot hearing the noise, the accused no. 1 and 4 threw something from their bike and flee from the spot. Later the above said accused and accused No. 7 to 14, 18 to 21 and other one identifiable accused came there on a motor cycle and scooter and created violence by throwing stones, stick and beer bottles on the road. Then the accused no. 1 in prosecution of their common object tried to hit on the head of CW1 who was trying to take CW2 and CW4 to hospital, using the steel pipe. CW1 managed to block the same using his hand and that resulted in an incised wound on his eyebrows and a fracture on his right hand small finger. The 2nd accused using the steel pipe beaten CW1 below his left hand knee. The 3rd accused beaten him on his right leg and thereby caused wound. The 4th accused beaten on his left ankle using the steel pipe. When CW1 fell down, the other accused attacked him by beating and kicking him. When the CW3 tried to save him, the accused no. 5 beaten him using steel pipe on his right leg knee. The accused have hence committed the offences punishable u/ss. 143, 147, 148, 341, 323, 324, 326, 294(b), 308, 506 (Para-1), 509 and 149 of IPC and sec. 3(a) of the Explosive Act.

3. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the relevant records.

4. The investigation has culminated into filing of the charge sheet. The petitioner is present with sufficient sureties. There is no ground to deny bail.

Hence the bail application is allowed on appropriate grounds:-

- (i) *Petitioner shall execute bail bond for Rs. 50,000/- with two solvent sureties each for the like sum.*
- (ii) *Petitioner shall not threaten, intimidate or influence the witnesses and shall not tamper with the evidence.*
- (iii) *Petitioner shall not commit similar offences during the bail period.*

If the petitioner violate any of the bail conditions, he shall be liable to be re-arrested on forfeiture of the bail bond.
