Manpreet Singh @ Mani Vs. State

Heard on the bail application filed by counsel for applicant-accused Manpreet Singh @ Mani in case FIR No. 125 dated 03.05.2026, under Sections 118(1), 126(2), 190, 191 BNS/324,341, 148, 149 IPC, P.S. Lehra. It is alleged in the application that the applicant-accused has been falsely implicated in the present FIR. He is innocent and has not committed any offence. Hence the accused be admitted to bail.

Notice of bail application was issued to State, however, learned APP for the State did not file reply but opposed the bail application.

The remand papers has been minutely perused. The accused is in custody since 07.05.2026. At present the accused/applicant is in judicial custody for long period of time and no useful purpose will be served by keeping the accused in custody for indefinite period. The alleged recovery has already been effected from the accused. The challan in the present case is yet to be presented. Moreover, it is cardinal principal of the law ***bail is a rule and jail is an exception*** and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bars for any inordinate period. Therefore, the present bail application is allowed and the accused is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹ 30,000/- with one surety in the like amount subject to the following **conditions:-**

- i. The accused/applicant shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
- ii. The accused/applicant shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing and shall comply with other conditions of the bond executed.
- iii. The accused/applicant shall not commit any offence similar to the offence, of which, he is accused or suspect of the commission of which he is suspected.
- iv. The accused/applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.
- v. The accused/applicant and surety shall be bound to intimate the Court as and when they change their given addresses.

Requisite bail bonds and surety bonds furnished which are accepted and attested. Release warrants be issued immediately. Papers be attached with main file/remand papers.
