These petitions are coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Sri.Sebastian.K.Jacob, Advocate for the petitioner/Accused in all petitions; and of Addl. Public Prosecutor represented for the respondent/Complainant in all petitions, and the court passed the following:-

**COMMON ORDER**

Petitioner is the accused in SC.38/2026. The above case was charge sheeted by the Iritty Police for offences punishable u/ss.324, 294(b), 307 and 201 of IPC.

2. CMP 6/2026 is filed for exempting the petitioner from personal appearance in court. CMP 7/2026 is filed seeking permission to renew his passport No 1003998 for a period of two years. CMP 8/2026 is filed seeking permission of court to go to gulf for a period of two years. Hence the petitions.

3. Report is filed by the prosecution objecting the petition. It is stated that he may abscond and thereby the trial of the case will be affected.

4. Heard both sides. Perused the records. Considering the fact that the petitioner only wants exemption from personal appearance, to renew his

passport and permission to go to gulf for two years these petitions can be allowed. The apprehension entertained by the prosecution can be given due weightage and sufficient conditions imposed to prevent petitioner from absconding. This petition can be allowed subject to the following conditions:

1. The petitioner shall file a special Vakalat.
2. Fresh bail bond shall be executed by him for Rs.1,00,000/- (Rupees one lakh only) with two sureties, who are willing to stand as his sureties when he goes abroad.
3. He shall file an affidavit undertaking that he shall not contest his identity during trial and also undertake that he shall appear before Court within two years or as and when summoned.
4. The petitioner shall give his address wherein he is going to reside abroad and in which notice from court can be issued.
5. He shall produce copy of his renewed passport within 15 days of its renewal.
6. At the end of the two years period from today ie., 03.06.2026, he shall appear before Court.

Subject to these conditions, the petitions are allowed. His counsel is permitted to represent him in court for framing charge and during trial. However, Sec.351(1)(b) of BNSS, questioning shall be answered by the petitioner himself. He shall appear back before court on or before 03-06-2028.
