This compounding petition coming on this day for hearing before in the presence of Appellant/ Accused and respondent No.2/complainant; the court passed the following

ORDER

It is an application filed to compound the offence. It is submitted that the entire matter has been settled between the parties. The respondent company is represented by Sri Pradeep Kumar, the Branch Manager of the company. He submits that the entire matter has been settled between the parties and that he may be permitted to withdraw the cheque amount of Rs. 1,19,985, which has been deposited by the accused before the trial court. In pursuance of the aforesaid sworn testimony, the trial court was directed to release the amount to the complainant company. A report has been received from the trial court stating

that the entire cheque amount has been released to the complainant. The learned counsel for the complainant company also submits that they have received the entire cheque amount. Since the entire matter has been settled between the parties and the complainant company has received the cheque amount, this compounding application is allowed and the accused is acquitted under Section 320(8) of the Cr.P.C.
