This application coming on the 18th October, 2025 day for final hearing before me in the presence of the Addl. Public Prosecutor for the complainant and having stood over for consideration till this day, the court passed the following:-

ORDER

This is an application filed by the accused from jail seeking speedy trial of the above case.

2. The petitioner is arrayed as an accused in a case alleging offences punishable under Section 307 of the IPC, wherein the accused is alleged to have attempted to commit the murder of the de facto complainant. The accused was earlier released on bail by this Court, considering the period of detention undergone at that time.

3. However, the accused jumped bail in this case. Subsequently the petitioner was arrested and produced in connection with another offence allegedly committed during the pendency of the bail, wherein the accused is stated to have committed the murder of another person.

4. Be that as it may, a speedy trial is a right guaranteed under Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

5. However, in view of the pendency of numerous sessions cases from the previous year, and considering the fact that the court calendar is already fully scheduled with other serious offences, the trial in this case is tentatively proposed to be taken up from February 2026. Hence trial can be scheduled in the month of February 2026.

Accordingly, the Criminal Miscellaneous Application is disposed as above.
