JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/s. **U/Ss. 125(b) Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita & Sec. 281 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita.**

2. The Accused is absent. Accused pleaded guilty through counsel to the charge framed for the above said offence. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

3. In the result, the Accused convicted for the offence punishable under Section 125(b) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.10000/- In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 7 Days. The Accused is further convicted for the offence punishable under Section 281 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.1000/- In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 7 Days. If fine amount U/s. 125(b) is realized it shall be paid to CW1 as compensation under Sec. 395 of BNSS.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
