JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/ss. 281 and Sec. 125(a) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhitha.

2. Accused present. Copy served. Particulars of the above said offence are read over and explained to the accused to which accused pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the accused accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

3. In the result, the accused is found guilty and convicted and is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹1,000/- under Section 281 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and ₹2,000/- under Section 125(a) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita. In default of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of 7 days under each section. If the fine amount realized under Section 125(a) BNS is realized, the same shall be paid to CW1 as compensation.
