JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State Police alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 20 of **Protection of River Banks and Regulation of Removal of Sand Act, 2001 (Kerala)** , U/Sec 379 of IPC \ , U/Sec 3(I),R/W181,190(2),146R/W196 of **Motor Vehicle Act** \ .

2. The Accused is present. The particulars of the above said offence are read over and explained to the Accused to which Accused pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, the Accused convicted for the offence punishable under Section 3(I),R/W181,190(2),146R/W196 of the **Motor Vehicle Act** \ and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.8000/- The Accused is further convicted for the offence punishable under Section 379 of the IPC \ and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.2000/-and simple imprisonment till the rising of the court.. The Accused is further convicted for the offence punishable under Section 20 of the **Protection of River Banks and Regulation of Removal of Sand Act, 2001 (Kerala)** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.10000/-.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
