This petition is coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of S/Sri.Denny George & Joju J Mannur, Advocates for the Petitioner/Accused and the Court passed the following:-

**ORDER**

1. This application was filed under **Section 483(1)(b)** of the **BNSS** by the accused to modify the condition No.6 in the bail order. The bail was granted to the petitioner on 06.02.2026 by vide CMP 02/2026 in a murder case with a condition that **“The petitioner shall not enter the limits of the Kannur district except to comply with the third condition until further orders.”**

2. Now he is residing in Kasaragod District and wants to reside in his own residence with his aged parents. The occurrence was on 20.03.2025, and the final report was filed on 16.06.2025. After eleven months of custody, the bail was granted to him by this court on 06.02.2026. After one year from the occurrence,

there is no need to continue the same scenario until the case is disposed of. The police filed a report raising concerns about the tampering of prosecution evidence.

3. The witnesses reside within the jurisdiction of the Pariyaram police station, and the residence of the accused is within the jurisdiction of the Alakkode police station, 25 km from the place of occurrence. It is found that an unmarried coolie worker residing at his residence with his parents will be more comfortable for a reformation and to support his livelihood. In light of the above observation, the petition is allowed. Therefore, this court is inclined to modify conditions No.6 and 7 as,

**6. The petitioner shall not enter the limits of the Pariyaram police station, except with the prior permission of the investigation officer, in writing.**

**7. The petitioner shall appear before the SHO of Alakode police station at 10.00 am on every Sunday until further orders.**
