ORDER

Accused/applicant has moved the present bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the applicant-accused has argued that the applicant-accused is innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. He further argued that the applicant is in custody ever since 27.12.2019. He further argued that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation and no useful purpose would be served to keep the applicant behind the bar. He thus prays for grant of bail.

On the other hand, learned. Addl. PP for the state has opposed the bail application on the ground of seriousness of the offence.

Record has been received and perused. Perusal of the same shows that 5 grams Heroin was recovered from the possession of accused which is non commercial quantity. Accused has been coming in custody ever since 27.12.2019 and no useful purpose would be served to keep the petitioner behind the bar. It will take long time for the trial to be completed, so, in these circumstances, the present application is allowed and the applicant is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail and surety bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Illaqa/Duty Magistrate. Bail application be tagged with the record of main case.
