**JUDGMENT**

Accused present. Copy given. Particulars of offences were read over and explained to him. Accused pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the accused pleaded guilty voluntarily, with the full understanding of legal consequence. Hence his plea is accepted. Accused is found guilty U/s. 20(b)(ii)(A) of NDPS Act. He is convicted thereunder. This is not a fit case to invoke benevolent provisions of Probation of Offenders Act.

In the result, accused is convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 10,000/- U/s. 20(b)(ii)(A) of NDPS Act and IDSI for 7 days. Convict shall execute bond of Rs. 30,000/- for a period of 3 year as provided u/s.34 of NDPS Act with one surety.

Remnants of NDPS, if any, received back after chemical examination, shall be destroyed as per rules through Drugs Disposal Committee. The office is directed to put up the other properties if any, produced in this case, for making an order U/s. 60 of NDPS Act.
