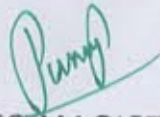

JUDGMENT

Accused absent. Copy given. Particulars of offences were read over and explained to him through the counsel. Accused pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the accused pleaded guilty to the charge, voluntarily. Hence the plea is accepted. Accused is found guilty U/s. 15(c) r/w 63 of Abkari Act. He is convicted thereunder. This is not a fit case to invoke benevolent provisions of Probation of Offenders Act.

In the result, accused is convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 2500/- U/s. 15(c) r/w 63 of Abkari Act and in default of payment of fine, to suffer simple imprisonment for 20 days.
