3. Substance of the complaint :

Prosecution alleges that on 08<sup>th</sup> July 2021, on the basis of telephonic information that sanitizer and cosmetic were manufactured and sold from the premises of Lana Soap and Detergents Industries, Parambil, P.O.Chavassery (accused No.1) without a valid manufacturing drug license / manufacturing cosmetic license, the complainant inspected the said premises and found that stored manufactured drugs, cosmetic, raw material for manufacturing, packing material and label for finished products without a valid manufacturing drug license / manufacturing cosmetic license. On investigation, it is found that the drug seized is spurious drugs under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act. Accused No.2 and 3 are Managing Partner and Partner of the accused No.1. Hence, all the accused are said to have committed the offence punishable under Sections 32, 18A(1) and 18(c), 27(c) and 27(b)(ii) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940.

## ORDER

This a complaint filed by Drugs Inspector, Drug Inspector(IB), Office of Assistant Drug Controller, Kannur, against the accused persons for the offence punishable under sections 32, 18A(1) and 18(c), 27(c) and 27(b)(ii) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940.

2. Prosecution case in brief is as follow: On 08<sup>th</sup> July 2021, on the basis of telephonic information that sanitizer and cosmetic were manufactured and sold from the premises of Lana Soap and Detergents Industries, Parambil, P.O.Chavassery (accused No.1) without a valid manufacturing drug license / manufacturing cosmetic license, the complainant inspected the said premises and found that stored manufactured drugs, cosmetic, raw material for manufacturing, packing material and label for finished products without a valid manufacturing drug license / manufacturing cosmetic license. On investigation, it is found that the drug seized is spurious drugs under the Drugs and Cosmetics Act. Accused No.2 and 3 are Managing Partner and Partner of the accused No.1. Hence, all the accused are said to have committed the offence punishable under Sections 32, 18A(1) and 18(c), 27(c) and 27(b)(ii) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940.

4. On receipt of summons, accused persons appeared before the court and filed bail continuing memo and that was allowed. It is seen that accused were enlarged on bail as per the bail order No.Crl.MP.No.4994/2024 in SC.56/2023 of the Hon'ble Session Court, Thalassery. All relevant copies of prosecution records were furnished to the accused and thereby the requirements under Section 230 of BNSS was duly complied with. The offence under Sections 32, 18A(1) and 18(c), 27(c) and

27(b)(ii) of Drugs and Cosmetics Act 1940 is triable exclusively by the Court of Session. Therefore the case against the accused is to be committed to the Hon'ble Court of Session Thalassery under Section 232 of BNSS.

5. Transmit the case records to the Hon'ble Court of Session, Thalassery and the property produced if any, shall be sent subject to rule 77(2) of the Criminal Rules of Practice, Kerala.

6. The accused shall appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Thalassery as and when the court so directs.

7. Notify the commitment of the case to the Public Prosecutor.
