Heard, perused the records and passed the following:

J U D G M E N T

1. Accused stands trial for the offence punishable U/S. 126(2), 115(2) and 296(b) of BNS. The gist of the prosecution case is that on 27.11.2024 at Kallyad amsom in Padiyoor Grama panchayath at unnumbered house situated in Ward 4, Padiyoor Panchayath on the western side of Alathuparamba-Tayikundam road, the accused held the injured by her hair, abused and kicked on her stomach and caused injury to her hand. Thereby the accused committed offences punishable under 126(2), 115(2) and 296 of BNS.

2. In pursuance of same, Crime No. 776/2024 was registered by Irikkur Police under 126 (2) , 115(2) and 296 (b) of BNS. Subsequently, A final report was filed by Irikkur Police Station and cognizance was taken upon the same

by this court and the same was taken on file as CC No. 1/2025.

3. Although summons was issued to accused, accused did not appear before this court. Subsequently accused was arrested and produced before this court and accused was let off on a self bond. Accused breached the same. Plea was recorded and accused had pleaded not guilty and copy given. After the accused absconded, accused was arrested and produced before this court on 25.03.2026 and accused was remanded under Section 478(2) of BNSS. Subsequently accused pleaded guilty. I find that the plea of accused is voluntary. The accused was asked whether he is pleading guilty voluntarily and he has replied that he is pleading guilty voluntarily. The same has been endorsed on the plea form. The offences alleged are U/s 126(2), 115(2) and 296(b) of BNS.

In the result, The accused is sentenced to imprisonment of 3 months under Section 115(2) of BNS. The accused is sentenced to imprisonment of 1 month under Section 126 (2) of BNS and accused is sentenced to an imprisonment of 1 month under Section 296 (b) of BNS. IDSI Accused shall pay fine of Rs.10,000/-. Set off is allowed for the period from 25.03.2026 to 23.04.2026, the period already undergone by him as under trial prisoner. All the sentences shall run concurrently.
