This is an application u/s 482 of BNSS 2023 received from the Filing Counter moved on behalf of applicant for grant of anticipatory bail.

Reply to anticipatory bail of applicant received alongwith copy of GD No. 57-A dated 21.07.2026 as per which HC Vikram appears to have gone out of station to Bihar with regard to execution of NBWs in one case.

As per Circular No. 59/2011 issued by Special CP, Law & Order, Delhi Police which deals with regard to bail matters and pairvi, in case, IO is unable to attend the Court due to some contingency, Inspector (Investigation) or SHO shall personally attend the Court. No substitute shall be sent at his / her place during the bail hearing.

None has appeared from PS Sangam Vihar.

SHO, PS Sangam Vihar has failed to comply with aforesaid circular issued by his own Department.

Issue show cause notice to SHO PS Sangam Vihar as to why disciplinary action should not be recommended against him for non compliance of circular No. 59/2011 for 23.07.2026.

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SHO PS Sangam Vihar is directed to come with knowledge of complete facts of the case on NDOH.

It is pertinent to mention that circulars issued by a Department are enforceable (UCO Bank Ltd. Vs. CIT (1999) 4 SCC 599).
