This case coming on for today's proceedings, the Court passed the following:-

ORDER

1. This is a petition filed u/s.228 of BNSS by the counsel for accused.
2. **The petition averments in brief is as follows:-** The petitioner is the accused in the aforesaid case. The offences alleged against him are u/s. 281,106(1) of BNS & sec.184(iv)(f) of MV Act. The petitioner/accused got a job as driver at STS Group, Dubai. This petition is filed for exemption of his personal appearance. The petitioner is ready to abide any condition imposed by this Court.
3. Copy served to prosecution. Report filed.
4. Heard both sides.

5. On perusal of the case records, it is seen that the petitioner is the accused in the above case and he is on bail. I am of the view that the reason stated in the petition is sufficient enough to give exemption of personal appearance of the accused u/s.228 of BNSS.
6. In the result,
7. This petition is allowed. The petitioner/accused is exempted from appearing before the Court for a period of one year. However, he shall be present before the court as and when specifically required by the court. The petitioner shall file affidavit disclosing his residential and official address abroad.
