This petition, filed by the accused directly from the Jail through the Jail Superintendent and the court has passed the following:-

ORDER

The prosecution case, briefly, is as follows:- The accused with the intention to outrage the modesty of the informant, on 14.01.2026 at 08.00 p.m approached her near Thakidiyel House, Thaibhagam bhagam on Kailathukavala - Kizhakkekavala road and caught hold on her hand and thereby outraged the modesty. Thus, the accused has committed the offence punishable u/ss. 126(2), 74 of BNS.

2. The accused was arrested on 17.01.2026 and produced before this court on 17.01.2026 and remanded to judicial custody.

3. Copy of the application was served to the learned APP. Perused the records.

4. The petitioner is in judicial custody till date. Since, he was not represented by a lawyer of his own choice, matter was intimated to District Legal Services Authority. On 26.03.2026, the accused filed this bail application from jail directly through Superintendent, Special Sub Jail, Ponkunnam.

5. The petitioner contends that, he is in judicial custody for the last 70 days and has no other persons to release him on bail as his parents expired. The accused prays for an interim bail or release him in self bond.

7. On perusal of the prosecution records and the report submitted by the investigating officer it is seen that the accused is in the judicial custody for the last 82 days and final report filed in this case. Considering the period of incarceration undergone by the accused and the stage of investigation, I am inclined to allow this bail application.

In the result, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on interim bail till summons is issued in this case upon his executing a self bond of Rs.10,000/- on condition that within the said period of his release on temporary bail, he shall comply with the terms and conditions stipulated in this order.

1. The accused shall execute a self bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only).
2. He shall not commit any other offences while on bail.

Communicate the order to the Superintendent of the jail concerned.
