This case having come up for consideration on 21.05.2026, the court on the same day passed the following:-

ORDER

Originally this case was taken on file as CC 978/2023 of Judicial First Class Magistrate Court-I, Changanacherry. As per the order the Hon'ble Chief Judicial Magistrate Court, Kottayam the case was transferred to this court and it was refiled as CC 873/2023.

2. The accused person in this case is alleged to have committed the offence punishable u/s. 420 of IPC. On appearance of the accused person charge was read over and explained u/ss. 420 of IPC. Accused person pleaded not guilty and

claimed to be tried. CW1 is present and examined as PW1. PW1 and accused filed CMP 01/2026 along with CMP 02/2026 to compound the offence. Section 420 of IPC can be compounded by the person mentioned in the third column of the table provided u/s. 320 of Cr.P.C. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused that the matter has been settled between the parties. Hence permission is granted for compounding the offences.

In the result, CMP is allowed. The accused person is acquitted u/s.320(8) of Cr.P.C. Bail bond executed by the accused person stands cancelled and he is set at liberty.
