**ORDER**

This is an application filed by the counsel for the accused to release the accused on bail.

The Learned APP opposed the application vehemently. On the other hand, the learned counsel for the accused submitted that some leniency may be taken.

I have gone through the entire case records in this case. The matter is of the year 2018 and the crime was registered in the year 2017. From the very first posting date onwards the accused has been absent and a warrant was issued against him. Subsequently on 29.11.2018 the accused was arrested and produced and he was released on bail. Thereafter he again remained absent when witnesses were summoned. On perusing the order sheet, it can be seen that from 24.02.2022 the accused has been continuously absent and a warrant was repeated against him. Finally on 25.11.2023 the case against the accused was moved to the register of long pending cases as LP 48/2023. Today the accused is again arrested and

produced. The case records reveal the intention of the accused with respect to his conduct of the case. The attitude of the accused shows that he is least interested in prosecuting his crime. On asking, the accused even stated that he was not aware of this case, in which he was once arrested and released on bail. Charge was framed and read over to him also. The attitude of the accused had led to lagging the case for the last 8 years. Such an accused is not entitled to any leniency. Hence I am not inclined to release the accused on bail. Hence, the bail application is dismissed.

**In the result, CMP is dismissed**
