**JUDGMENT**

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 146, 196 of **MOTOR VEHICLES ACT** , U/Sec 281 of **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita** .

2. The Accused is present. The particulars of the above said offence are read over and explained to the Accused to which Accused pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, the Accused convicted for the offence punishable under Section 146, 196 of the **MOTOR VEHICLES ACT** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.2000/-. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 10 Days. The Accused is further convicted for the offence punishable under Section 281 of the **Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.300/-. In case of the default of the Accused in paying the said fine amount, Accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 10 Days.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
