An applicationu/O 1 Rule 10 CPC read with Order VI Rule 17 CPC and section 151 CPC has been filed seeking amendment in the plaint. The applicant i.e. Guru Nanak Public School wants itself tobe replaced by Shri Guru Singh Sabha, Rajouri Garden, Delhi which is stated to be a registered society under the Act of 1860. The application on the very face of it does not make any difference in so far as the status and capacity of the plaintiff is concerned as even a registered society is not a jurisdict entity more particularly in the light of the provision under section 6 of the Act 1860. Accordingly, the application in hand is disposed of as dismissed.

Plaintiff is afforded one more opportunity to make the suitable amendment (if deemed fit) by moving appropriate application within 3 working days, failing which the plaintiff would be liable to pay cost of Rs. 1000/- for each days' delay, to be deposited with DLSA, West.
