- ORDER : The case against the accused committed to the Court of Sessions, Kottayam under section 209 of Cr.P.C.

ORDER

The final report in this case was filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, Thrikkodithanam Police Station in Crime no.1239/2023 against the accused, for offence punishable u/s.323, 324, 326, 294(b), 506, 353, 332 and 333 r/w 34 of IPC.

2. The prosecution case, in brief, is as follows:- The 1st accused and CCL were spotted in suspicious circumstances at Maliyekkalpadi Bhagom on

12.08.2023 at 05.40 p.m by the informant and his police party while they were on patrolling duty. A1 and CCL got enraged when questioned regarding whereabouts and they assaulted and thrashed the informant and one Bijumon, the ASI who accompanied the informant. A1 fisted them, while CCL hit with a mobile phone on the left side of informant's head, at least 7-8 times, causing him intense pain and slapped on the left cheek of ASI Bijumon. When they were being taken into custody, A1 and CCL obstructed the officers by closing the door of department vehicle, thereby resulting in CPO Selvaraja's ring finger getting bruised and bone being fractured. Thus, the accused have committed the offence punishable under sections 323, 324, 326, 294(b), 506, 353, 332 and 333 r/w 34 of IPC.

3. On filing final report, the case was mistakenly taken on file as CC 1772/2023 and summons was issued to the accused pursuant to which he appeared before the court. During the course of enquiry it was noticed that the case was exclusively triable by the Hon'ble Court of Session and hence it was refiled as CP 102/2023. Copies of the prosecution records were furnished to the accused. As the case is exclusively triable by the Court of Session, it is committed to Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Kottayam as contemplated under section 209(a) of Cr.P.C.

4. The entire records and material objects, if any, shall be forwarded to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions forthwith. The accused shall appear before the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Kottayam as and when the Court directs.

5. Issue notice to the Public Prosecutor, Kottayam regarding the

committal of this case.
