ORDER:

This order will decide this application moved by the
accused/applicant seeking interim bail from 20.11.2020 to 30.11.2020
for making arrangement for the marriage of his sister schedule to be
solemnized on 22.11.2020 at Faridkot.

2 Along with the application the applicant has also annexed
the wedding card showing that marriage of one Mandeep Kaur is to
be solemnized on 22.11.2020.

3 Notice of this application was given to the State but no reply has been filed. However, Addl. PP opposed the instant application.

4 The accused/applicant is claiming himself to be the brother of the bride Mandeep Kaur whose marriage is alleged to be taken place on 22.11.2020. The accused/applicant has been booked and sent to jail for commission of offence u/s 399, 402 of IPC and 25 Arms Act and 21/25/29 NDPS Act which is a serious offence. However, as the accused/applicant is claiming himself to be the brother of Mandeep Kaur whose marriage is to be solemnized on 22.11.2020 and being the brother of the bride, his presence seems to be essential for the performance of marriage customs/rituals. Accordingly, the present application stands partly allowed to the extent that accused/applicant is allowed to attend the marriage of his sister on 22.11.2020 from 10 AM to 4 PM under police escort. It is made clear that during this period of attending the marriage he will remain in police custody. The to and fro charges shall be borne by the accused/applicant. Afterwards he will be again lodged in District Jail, Barnala on the same day. A copy of this order be sent to the SSP, Barnala and Superintendent of District Jail, Barnala for compliance. Papers be attached with the other pending papers.
