This petition coming on this day for hearing before me in the presence of Sri.Sharafudheen Musliyar, advocate for the petitioner, and of Sri. Shaju. K. P, Addl. Public Prosecutor for the respondents, the court passed the following:-

ORDER

This is a petition filed by the counsel for the 2nd accused in SC.119/2025. The above case was charge sheeted by the Manjeri Police for offences punishable u/ss.123,275 r/w 3(5) BNS, Sec.118(i) KP Act and Sec.6 r/w 24 of COTPA Act.

2. It is stated in the petition that the petitioner/2nd accused surrendered his passport before this court as per the conditions in the bail order. Now the petitioner wants to go Qatar for visiting. For that purpose, he wants to release his passport for a period of three months. Hence, this petition is filed to release his passport for a period of three months to go Qatar for visiting. If the petition is not allowed, the petitioner will be put to irreparable loss and hardship.

3. Copy served to the respondent. Respondent filed report and prayed for dismissal of the petition.

4. Heard the counsel for the petitioner and respondent.

5. The main apprehension of the respondent is that if the petition

is allowed, there is every chance for absconding the petitioner/accused. The counsel for the petitioner/A2 submitted that the petitioner is ready to abide any conditions imposed by this Court.

6. I find merit on the submission of the counsel for the petitioner. Hence this petition is allowed and release the passport of the petitioner to him. The petitioner/A2 is permitted to go Qatar for a period of three months from today for visiting Qatar on the following conditions:-

a) The petitioner/A2 shall execute a bond for Rs.1,00,000/- with two solvent sureties each for the like sum;

b) The petitioner/A2 is permitted to go Qatar and stay there for a period of three months from today.

c) The counsel for the petitioner/A2 is permitted to appear before the court for and on behalf of the petitioner;

d) Petitioner/A2 shall surrender his passport in court and also will appear before the court within a period of three months from today to face the trial of the case;

e) Petitioner/A2 shall produce a copy of his passport before the court. Verified copy of the passport of the petitioner/A2 shall be kept in file before its release.
