Application for bail under Section 483 BNSS

ORDER:

1. The indulgence of the Court has been craved for by the applicant-accused by seeking regular bail under section 483 BNSS in above said FIR, on the averments that applicant/accused has been falsely implicated in the present case. There is no direct or indirect evidence against the applicant/accused to connect him with the commission of alleged crime. As the applicant/accused is ready to abide by all the terms

and conditions imposed upon him by the Court, he be released on regular bail and his bail application be allowed.

2. Notice of the bail application was issued to the respondent State and Ld.Addl.PP has prayed for dismissal of the bail application. Main file received.

3. The Court has given the thoughtful consideration to the rival contentions of both the parties and minutely perused the case file.

4. FIR in the case in hand stems in pursuance of statement Karandeep Singh son of Balwinder Singh, who had stated before the police authorities by submitting that he is learning the aluminum work from his brother Sharanjit Singh @ Sunny. He alongwith his friend Karan Kumar son of Ashok Kumar and Gobinda son of Baldev Singh on every Saturday used to immerse cereal at Kanjli Bein. On 18.03.2023 around 6.30 P.M he again his friends on motorcycle make Splendor bearing registration No.PB-09-AJ-3625 left for Kanjli Bein to immerse cereal. When they reached near the fish farm situated near Kanjli road, then from the side of Kanjli Bein, two young persons namely Inderjit Singh accused/applicant was seen armed with kirch and Ramandeep Sandhu was seen sitting at the back seat of the motorcycle came and Ramandeep Sandhu who was armed with kirch signalled them to stop. Meanwhile from their (complainant party) behind, three more motorcycles came and two motorcycles were having two riders each on it and one motorcycle was having three riders on it and they were also armed with kirchs and

datars and they also stopped them (complainant party). On this, they got perplexed/nervous and they descended from their motorcycle. Then one of the boys namely Inderjit Singh accused/applicant raised the lalkara that they (complainant party) should be caught and should not be spared and be done to death. On hearing this, he (complainant) alongwith Gobinda out of fear tried to run away but then Inderjit Singh inflicted his dasti kirch blow upon him which fell at the backside of his left shoulder. Then Ramandeep Sandhu inflicted his dasti kirch blow upon Gobinda which fell towards the left side of his abdomen. Further, complainant had submitted that at that time, Vicky was armed with kirch, David was armed with datat and Bhinda Kalu, Palley and Vicky were also laced with deadly weapons. Further, complainant had submitted that then all the above mentioned persons caught hold of Karan Kumar son of Ashok Kumar and they started inflicting injuries upon him with their weapons. Even accused/applicant Inderjit Singh and Ramandeep Sandhu also inflicted injuries upon him. Further, complainant had submitted that when they tried to get rescued/freed from the hands of above mentioned persons, on this, Ramandeep Sandhu inflicted his dasti kirch blow upon him (complainant) which fell at his back. However they managed to run away from the spot. Further, complainant had submitted that the above mentioned persons had infact seriously injured Karan Kumar with their weapons/kirch. Then he gave call to his brother and then his brother Sharanjit Singh @ Sunny came at the spot and then he (Sharanjit Singh)

got him (complainant) admitted at Civil Hospital, Kapurthala. Further, complainant had submitted that the motive behind the occurrence was that earlier Karan Kumar had dispute with the abovesaid boys and as such all the above mentioned persons had inflicted injuries upon them. In view of these allegations, the present FIR was registered against co-accused.

5. Perusal of the record reveals that accused/applicant was armed with kirch. Accused/applicant Singh accused/applicant raised the lalkara that complainant party should be caught and should not be spared and be done to death. On hearing this, he (complainant) alongwith Gobinda out of fear tried to run away but then Inderjit Singh inflicted his dasti kirch blow upon him which fell at the backside of his left shoulder. Accused/applicant Inderjit Singh and co-accused Ramandeep Sandhu also inflicted injuries upon Karan Kumar. As per injury report bearing No.JH/IR/62677/169 dated 23.03.2024 qua injured Karan Kumar shows 3 cm X 1 cm clean cut just below the nipple underlying lung visible, rib visible, air leak present. The nature of injuries was declared as dangerous to life.

6. The allegations against the applicant/accused of attempt to commit murder are very serious in nature. Life threatening injuries have been caused by sharp edged weapon. Mere period of custody cannot ipso-facto entitle the applicant to be released on bail. The gravity of offence, nature of accusations against the applicant and totality of circumstances is required to be considered.

7. Considering the serious nature of allegations levelled against the applicant in context of total factual matrix, no merit is found in the present bail application. Resultantly, the application for regular bail of the applicant is dismissed.
