

***FIR No.113 dated 20.06.2025,
Under Section 25 of Arms Act,
Police Station Nihal Singh Wala.***

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Application for releasing the accused/applicant on bail till decision of the case.

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Present:- Mr.Ramanpreet Singh, Learned APP for the State.
Sh.Gurpreet Singh Kangarh, Advocate for applicant/accused

1. Heard on the bail application.
2. Learned counsel for applicant-accused averred that the applicant-accused is quite innocent and has been falsely implicated in this case. As further averred, no recovery has been effected from the accused. As further averred, applicant/accused is in custody since 20.06.2025. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the applicant/accused behind bars and hence, the present bail application.
3. On the other hand, learned APP for the State has argued that serious allegations have been levelled against the accused and as such, request has been made that accused should not be granted the concession of the bail as prayed for.
4. Pertinently, the present FIR has been registered against the accused on the brief allegation that on 20.06.2025, on the basis of secret information, police party headed by SI Ranjit Singh and consisting of other police officials conducted raid at the disclosed place, where one person was present along-with one 315 bore desi pistol and two live cartridges and he was apprehended and one 315 bore desi pistol and two live cartridges was recovered, without any licence or permit. Pertinently, the allegations leveled against the accused is

grave and serious in nature. As such, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, modus operandi used by applicant/accused, gravity of the offences, this Court is of the considered opinion that it is not a fit case to extend the benefit of bail to the present applicant-accused Jagraj Singh @ Jagga @ Beedi. Accordingly, present bail application stands dismissed. Papers be attached with the remand papers.
