ORDER:

1 Applicants Balwinder Singh and Beg Singh, have filed the bail application under Section 438 Cr.P.C. and notice of the same was given to the State.

2 Heard. The record reveals that FIR no.15 dated 10.2.2015, 4.1.2017, under Sections 379, 420, 425, 427, 430 & 431 IPC and Sections 21(1) and 4(1) of Minerals and Mines Act, and Sections 3 and 4 of Damage to Public Property Act was registered at Police Station Rahon, against the present applicants and others, on the basis of the statement of Sudesh Kumar. The present applicant along with others were charge sheeted by the then Ld. CJM on 30.1.2017 and thereafter the case was fixed for the prosecution evidence. It was on 5.10.2018 present applicants Balwinder Singh and Beg Singh absented before the Ld. CJM and accordingly, their bail order was cancelled and their bail bonds and surety bonds were forfeited to the State and they were summoned through arrest warrants for 3.11.2018. On 3.11.2018, the Arrest warrants of the present applicants were received back un-executed and accordingly, fresh warrants of arrest with notice to their sureties were issued by the Ld. Trial Court for 1.12.2018. In these

circumstances the present bail application is disposed of with the observations that in case the present applicants/accused surrenders before the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate within 10 days from today and moves bail application, the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate is directed to dispose of the bail application of the applicant/accused on the same day. Trial Court record be returned forthwith and file of bail application be consigned to Record Room.
