Happy Singh Versus State of Punjab etc.

At the very outset, learned Additional Public Prosecutor, on the instructions from ASI Lachhman Singh, posted at Police Station Phul, has stated at bar that one FIR No.54 dated 2.8.2024, under Section 21(b), 27, 29 NDPS Act, Police Station Phul was registered against the petitioner and others. The investigation in the said FIR has already been culminated and the charge sheet has already been presented in the aforesaid FIR. The petitioner is already on bail. Except the aforesaid FIR, as per record, no other application, complaint, inquiry or FIR is pending against the petitioner till date. A separate statement of ASI Lachhman Singh has been recorded to the aforesaid effect in the Court.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner suffered a statement to the effect that he does not press his bail application qua FIR No.54 dated 2.8.2024, under Section 21(b), 27, 29 NDPS Act, Police

Station Phul, Bathinda and his present bail application be treated having been filed for other FIRs/complaints.

Keeping in view above, the present bail application is not considered for the FIR detailed in the statement of ASI Lakhman Singh today in Court. Since a categorical stand has been taken in court by the State on the basis of statement of ASI Lakhman Singh to the effect that no other complaint, application, FIR or any criminal proceedings are pending against the petitioner in Police Station Phul, the apprehension of the petitioner regarding his arrest, is meaning less and the present bail application is, therefore, dismissed. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to approach the Court a fresh, in case survivable cause arise to him in accordance with law. The bail application file be consigned to the Record room.
