This petition having been heard, the court on this day passed the following:

ORDER

This is a regular bail application filed by the sole accused as petitioner, who stands indicted for the offence punishable under section 20(b)(ii)B of NDPS Act.

2. The learned Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application stating that if the accused was again released on bail, he would abscond and commit similar offences.

3. Heard both sides.

4. Point for consideration-

Is the petition allowable as prayed for ?

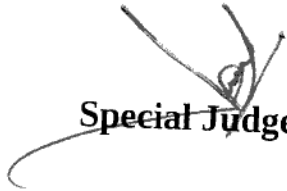
5. The record would show that the accused absconded when CW1 was present for giving evidence before this Court. Therefore, his bail bond was canceled and arrest warrant was issued. After prolonged search even extending to other states, he could be arrested and produced before this Court on 01.07.2025. Considering the past

conduct of the petitioner in this case as well as in another similar case, it is not advisable to release the petitioner on bail again at this stage.

In the result, the petition is dismissed.
