

Inderjit Singh Vs. State of Punjab BA (23-3-18)

Record received. SI Jagir Singh suffered a statement that applicant/accused has joined investigation on 21.6.2018 in pursuance of order dated 29.5.2018 passed by this court and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Ld. Addl. P.P. for the State and ld. Counsel for the complainant submitted that though applicant has joined investigation, he should not be granted anticipatory bail keeping in view the gravity of offence. I have considered respective submissions. Applicant/accused has already joined investigation in pursuance of order dated 29.5.2018 passed by this court. It has been stated by police official who has brought the record that his custodial interrogation is not required. In these circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by taking the applicant in custody. In view of these circumstances, without commenting upon other merits of the case, present bail application succeeds and is hereby allowed. Order dated 29.5.2018, whereby interim bail was granted to the applicant/accused is hereby made absolute, subject to conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of Cr. P.C. Police record be returned and file be consigned to record room.
