This petition having been finally heard on 19.12.2025 and the court on 20.12.2025 passed the following :-

**ORDER**

This is a petition filed by the petitioner under section 497 of BNSS so as to get the interim custody of Dominar D 400 Motor Cycle bearing registration no. KL 54 P 6902.

2. The respondent registered the above crime against the accused alleging commission of offence punishable u/s. 20(b)(ii)A of NDPS Act.

3. According to the petitioner she is the owner of the above said vehicle. The vehicle was seized by the Sub Inspector of Police, Kuttippuram Police Station from the accused in connection with the above crime. Since the vehicle is now in an unattended condition and there is every chance of deterioration, the petitioner prayed for the release of the vehicle

4. Notice has been given to APP. Report filed seriously opposing the

petition.

5. Heard both sides. The petitioner has produced copy of RC relating to the vehicle. The document produced by the petitioner would show that she is the owner of the above said vehicle and the respondent did not have any case that the respondent is not the owner of the vehicle. It is to be noted that owner of the vehicle would not suffer because of its remaining unused and it is of no use to keep the seized vehicle at Police Station for a longer period exposed to sun and rain. Hence SHO-Kuttippuram Police Station is directed to release the vehicle to the petitioner or to produce the same before court.

6. By considering the facts and circumstances, this petition is allowed subject to the following conditions.

1. The petitioner shall execute a bond for Rs. 3,00,000/- with two solvent sureties each for like sum.
2. The petitioner shall produce the photographs of the above vehicle duly signed by the SHO of Police, Kuttippuram Police Station along with CD/Pendrive.
3. Petitioner shall produce copy of RC and Insurance certificate of the vehicle along with original for verification at the time of executing bond.
4. The petitioner shall not alienate or in any manner encumber the vehicle without the permission of the court and shall kept the same in good condition.
5. Petitioner shall produce the vehicle before this court as and when directed to do so.
