Heard on the application moved by applicant for releasing of vehicle i.e. Motor Cycle make Platina bearing Registration No. PB-25J-6635, Model 2024 on sapurdari to the applicant. Police report called and perused. As per the police report, the above said vehicle has taken into police possession in case bearing FIR no. 26 of 2026, under sections 118(1), 115(2), 351(2), 190, 191(3) BNS, Police Station Hathur. Local police has raised no objection on releasing the above-said vehicle on sapurdari to the applicant. No useful purpose would be served by letting the case property detained in police station. It will be vulnerable to deterioration by natural forces and human acts. Hence, it is ordered that Motor Cycle make Platina bearing Registration No. PB-25J-6635, Model 2024 on sapurdari to applicant on furnishing sapurdari bonds in the sum of Rs.70,000/-with one surety in the like amount subject to following undertaking:-

1. To produce the case property on each and every date of hearing without notice of the Court,
2. Not to change colour and structure of the case property and will not alienate the same till the pendency of the trial, and;
3. All the signatory to bonds shall intimate the court their new residential addresses as and when they changes the same.
4. To forfeit the amount of bonds to State of Punjab in case of any violation.

Sapurdari bonds furnished, which have been accepted and attested. Release warrants be issued forthwith. Application disposed off accordingly. Papers be attached with the main file or otherwise consigned to the record room.
