This application coming on this day for orders, upon perusing the petition and after hearing Sri. P.B. Harris for the petitioner, the Addl. Public Prosecutor on behalf of the State and this court passed the following:-

**ORDER**

CMP is filed for return of the passport and permitting this petitioner to travel abroad.

2. Present petitioner is the 3<sup>rd</sup> accused in the above Sessions Case. In the affidavit it is stated that the petitioner is working as Cook in the Gulf and as per the bail order, this petitioner has surrendered his passport on 24-02-2026. Petitioner is required to rejoin his employment during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of next month otherwise his employment will be terminated. So the present petition is filed.

3. Heard the counsel.

4. Sub Inspector, Alathur Police Station filed objection stating that if the petition is allowed it will cause delay in disposing the Sessions Case.

5. But it is seen from the affidavit that passport if not returned he will lost his job. So considering the same, I allow the petition and the petitioner is permitted to go abroad for a period of one year from today and passport is ordered to be returned on condition by executing a bond for ₹1,00,000/- (Rupees One Lakh only) with two solvent sureties each for like sum. The petitioner shall appear before the court as and when required by the court for trial. He shall also furnish his residential as well as his employment address abroad, before the court within one month after joining for employment.
