**ORDER**

This petition (CMP) is filed for exempting the personal appearance of petitioner, who is 3<sup>rd</sup> accused in the SC and permit him to appear through the counsel.

2. In the affidavit it is stated that petitioner is working as Cook in abroad, in Gulf and he submitted that he will not dispute the identity and ready to appear before the court as and when directed by this court.

3. The SHO Alathur Police Station filed objection stating that if the present petition is allowed it will affect the proceedings of this case.

Heard the counsels.

4. **Point** :- Whether this petitioner is permitted to dispense his personal appearance before this court?

5. On going through this case, it is seen that this case of the year 2025 and there will be no possibility to take this case for trial in the near future. Further this petitioner is working as Cook in abroad. If he is to be directed to appear in all posting dates it will of course affect his job. So I am of the view that this petition can be allowed and hence petition is allowed and the personal appearance of the petitioner is dispensed with, otherwise he will lose his job in abroad. He is permitted to appear through his counsel and shall be present before the court as and when directed by this court.
