This petition coming on this day for hearing, the Tribunal passed the following:-

**AWARD**

This is an application filed by the petitioner for compensation for the injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident under section 166(1) (a) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

2. Case of the petitioner is that on 22.01.2024 at about 8.45 a.m., while the petitioner was travelling as pillion rider in the motor cycle bearing registration No.KL-45/S-401 and when it reached at Thiruvullakkavu bus stop, the bus bearing

registration No.KL-08/BU-6809 driven by the 1<sup>st</sup> respondent in a rash and negligent manner hit on petitioner's vehicle thereby the petitioner was sustained serious injuries. Hence the petition for a total compensation of ₹1,50,000/-.

3. When the matter was pending before this Tribunal the petitioner and the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent settled the matter for a total sum of ₹2,20,000/- (Rupees two lakh twenty thousand only) as compensation in full and final settlement and filed joint statement.

4. In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent has agreed to deposit the amount of 2,20,000/- (Rupees two lakh twenty thousand only) within one month from the date of award.

5. In case of default the amount will carry interest @ 9% p.a. from the date of default.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent shall deposit the balance amount within one month, to the bank account of the petitioner shown below by way of electronic transfer.
