This petition coming on this day for hearing, the Tribunal passed the following:-

AWARD

This is an application filed by the petitioner for compensation for the injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident under section 166(1) (a) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

2. Case of the petitioner is that on 20.04.2025 at about 7.30 p.m., while the petitioner was walking through the road side at Kunnamkulam, a motor cycle bearing registration No.KL-65/E-8289 ridden by the 1st respondent in a rash and negligent

manner hit the petitioner thereby the petitioner was sustained serious injuries. Hence the petition for a total compensation of ₹7,00,000/-.

3. When the matter was pending before this Tribunal the petitioner and the 2nd respondent settled the matter for a total sum of ₹7,25,000/- (Rupees seven lakh twenty five thousand only) as compensation in full and final settlement and filed joint statement.

4. In view of the settlement arrived at between the parties the 2nd respondent has agreed to deposit the amount of ₹7,25,000/- (Rupees seven lakh twenty five thousand only) within one month from the date of award.

5. In case of default the amount will carry interest @ 9% p.a. from the date of default.

The 2nd respondent shall deposit the balance amount within one month, to the bank account of the petitioner shown below by way of electronic transfer.
