J U D G M E N T

This is a case instituted upon the final report filed by the Sub Inspector of Police, Thrithala Police Station in Crime No. 366/2024 alleging offence punishable under Sec. 27(b) of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985.

2. Prosecution allegation in brief is that: On 19/05/2024 at 13.30 hours, the accused was found smoking ganja beedi in the road side of Karimbanakadavu public road. Thus the accused alleged to have committed the above said offence.

3. On 24/03/2026, the accused arrested and produced before the court and he was remanded to judicial custody to appear on 25/03/2026. Today the accused produced before the court. Copy of relevant prosecution records were furnished to him. After perusal of prosecution records particulars of offence read over explained to the accused to which he pleaded guilty. The implication of conviction and seriousness of offences were elaborated to the accused, despite explaining the consequences to him, the accused remained steadfast in his stand. Therefore I am satisfied that the accused pleaded guilty, voluntarily and without any compulsion and fully knowing about the consequences of pleading guilty. Therefore, the plea of guilt is accepted. The accused is found guilty for the offence punishable under section Sec. 27(b) of NDPS Act and is convicted thereunder. The accused was heard on question of sentence. He pleaded for leniency in sentence. Therefore I am of the view that the following sentence will meet the ends of justice.

In the result,

The accused is convicted on his plea of guilty under Sec. 264 Bharatiya Nagaik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for the offence punishable under Sections 27(b) NDPS Act. The accused is sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment for a period of 1 day for the offence punishable under 27(b) NDPS Act. The accused is entitled to get set off for the period of under trial detention undergone by him in this case under Sec. 468 of Bharatiya Nagaik Suraksha Sanhita for a period from 24/03/2026 to 25/03/2026.
