- Complainant :- State represented by the Sub Inspector of Police, Thrithala Police Station, Crime No. 572/2025.

- Accused :- Faisal .T @ Koombu Faisal, aged 51 years, S/o. Moidutty, Thadathilakath House, Odiyanpadi, Njangattiri, Pattambi Taluk, Palakkad.

- Offence :- Punishable under Sections 126(2), 351(2), 296(b) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and section 75 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.
- Sentence or Order :- The case against the accused is committed to the Hon'ble Court of Sessions, Palakkad for trial.

**ORDER**

The accused is charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector, Thrithala Police Station in Crime No. 572/2025 alleging commission of offences punishable under Sections 126(2), 351(2), 296(b) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 75 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.

2. The prosecution allegation in brief is as follows : The allegation is that on 10.10.2025 at about 12.30 a.m., while the CW1 along with her younger daughter Haleema Minha (aged 12) and elder daughter Henna Fargina were travelling from Kozhikode Airport to their house at Njangattiri in a car bearing registration No. KL-52 U 4885, after passing the Njangattiri petrol pump and when they reached in front of the house of the accused, the accused wrongfully restrained the car in which the CW1 and her children were travelling. It is further alleged that the accused shouted at them saying "I will kill you all", repeatedly hit on the bonnet of the car, intimidated them, and created fracas. Due to the said act of the accused, who is also the father of

the child and has a responsibility to protect her, the CW1's 12-year-old younger daughter Haleema Minha became frightened and suffered mental distress, along with other related consequences. Thus the accused alleged to have committed the aforesaid offences.

3. Final report resubmitted before the court on 06/02/2026 after compliance. On 05/03/2026, the accused appeared before the court and was released on bail as per the order of this court in CMP 01/2026 dated 05/03/2026. The copies of all relevant prosecution records were furnished to accused and thereby the requirements under section 230 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 was complied with.

4. The offences alleged against the accused are the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 351(2), 296(b) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and section 75 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015. As per section 86(4) of the Juvenile Justice Act, all offences punishable under the Act, is triable by Children's Court. Hence it is found that this case is exclusively triable by the Children's Court and to be committed to Hon'ble Sessions Court, Palakkad for trial as provided under section 362 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. The accused is directed to appear before Hon'ble Sessions Court as and when directed under sec 232(b) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

6. The case records and properties shall be submitted under section 232(c) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 before the Hon'ble Sessions Court when summoned.

6. The Public Prosecutor, Palakkad shall be notified regarding the committal of the case under section 232(d) of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
