JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the SHO Mannarkkad PS Cr-278/2024 alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 15(c) r/w 63 of **KERALA ABKARI ACT** .

2. The Accused is absent. Accused pleaded guilty through counsel to the charge framed for the above said offence. I am satisfied that the plea is made voluntary. Hence the plea of the Accused is accepted. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, I am satisfied that the following sentence shall meet the ends of the justice.

In the result, the Accused is convicted for the offence punishable under Section 15(c) r/w 63 of the **KERALA ABKARI ACT** and Accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs.700/-.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
