JUDGMENT

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 118(a) of Police Act,2010 .

2. The Accused is present. Copies of all relevant records produced by the prosecution were furnished to the accused. After hearing charge u/s. 118 (a) of Kerala Police Act framed, read over and explained to the accused, to which he pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea of guilty is voluntary. Plea is accepted. Heard accused on question of sentence. He sought for leniency. I am satisfied that this is not a fit case to invoke the benevolent provisions of Probation of Offenders Act. Since the accused is repented himself, I am satisfied that lenient view can be taken.

In the result, accused is convicted u/s. 264 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.500/- for the offence punishable u/s. 118 (a) Kerala Police Act. In default of payment of fine accused has to undergo simple imprisonment for five days.
