**JUDGMENT**

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 118(i) of Police Act, 1960 (Kerala) .

2. The Accused is present. Copies of all relevant records produced by the prosecution were furnished to the accused. After hearing charge u/s. 118 (i) of Kerala Police Act framed, read over and explained to the accused, to which he pleaded guilty. I am satisfied that the plea of guilty is voluntary. Plea is accepted. Heard accused on question of sentence. He sought for leniency. I am satisfied that this is not a fit case to invoke the benevolent provisions of Probation of Offenders Act. Since the accused is repented himself, I am satisfied that lenient view can be taken.

In the result, accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs.5,000/- for the offence punishable u/s. 118 (i) Kerala Police Act. In default of payment of fine accused has to undergo simple imprisonment for five days.

The properties produced in this case, if any, shall be disposed of as per law.
