**JUDGMENT**

1. This case is instituted upon the final report submitted by the State of Kerala (Police) alleging commission of offence punishable U/Sec 281 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita .
2. The Accused is Absent.Copies of all relevant records produced by the prosecution were furnished to the counsel. Particulars of offence read over and explained to the counsel for the accused, to which he pleaded guilty on behalf of the accused. I am satisfied that the plea of guilty is voluntary.
4. Plea of guilty is accepted and on the basis of the plea accused is found guilty of the offence punishable u/s. 281 of B.N.S and convicted u/s. 299 of B.N.S.S. Counsel for the accused pleaded for leniency on punishment. I am satisfied that this is not a fit case to invoke the benevolent provisions of the Probation of Offenders Act. Considering the nature and gravity of the offence accused is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 200/- u/s. 281 of B.N.S.
